- January 6 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)
- January 13 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee. (Psalm 119:11)
- January 20 Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path. (Psalm 119:105)
- January 27 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. (II Corinthians 4:3, 4)
